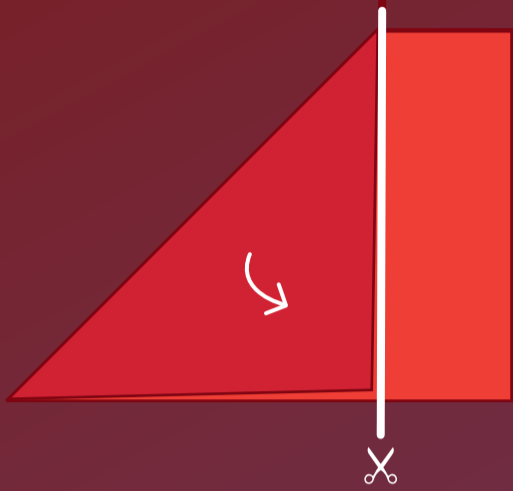
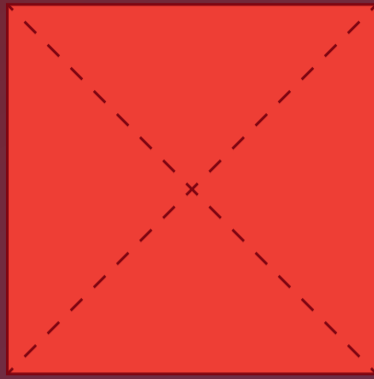


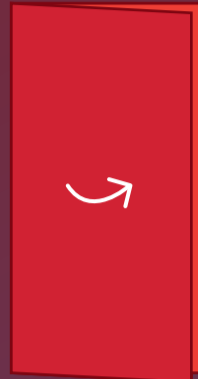
Make your own Christmas star



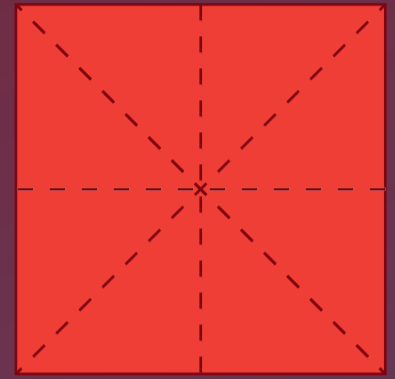
1 Create a square sheet of paper by folding one corner to one side. Cut off the excess paper.



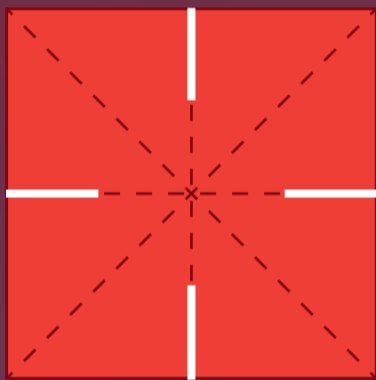
2 Fold the paper along the other diagonal. Unfold the paper.



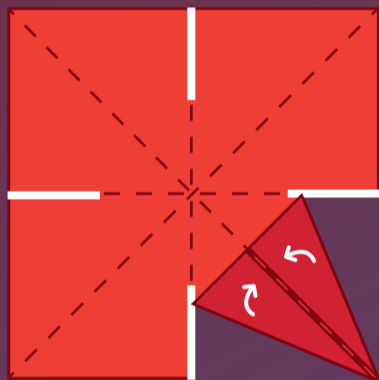
3 Fold the paper in half creating two rectangles.



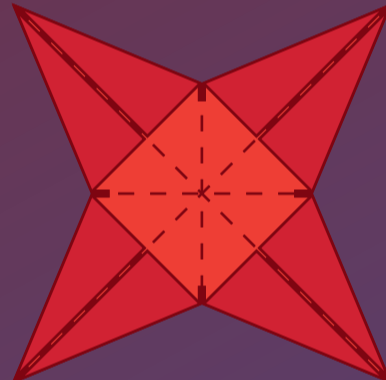
4 Unfold the paper again.



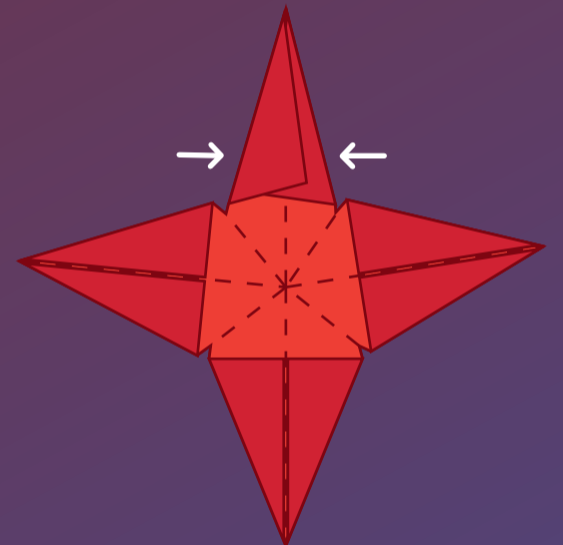
5 Along all four middle folding lines, cut half the distance of the paper.



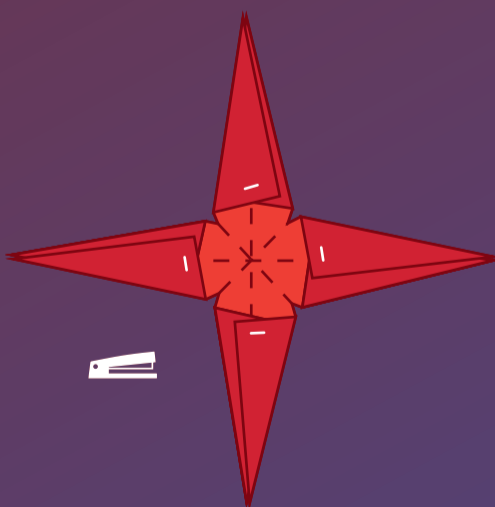
6 Fold both snippets in toward the center of the diagonal fold.



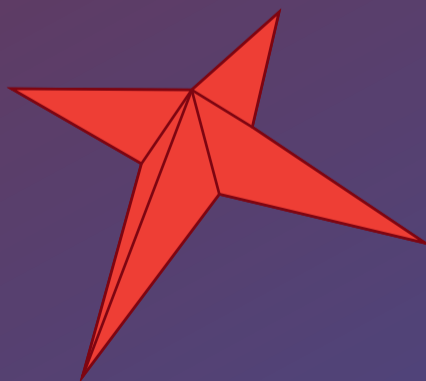
7 Continue all the way around until all four tips are folded in.



8 Push the flaps inward a little, so that the star points become three-dimensional.



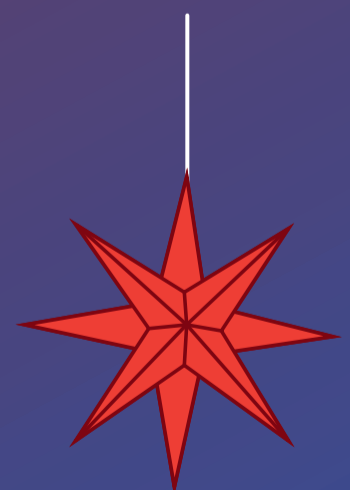
9 Staple inside to secure the two long flaps to each other. Repeat to create four large triangles.



10 Then the first half of the star is finished. Repeat steps 1 - 9 to make the other half of the star.



11 Attach the two halves together with double-sided tape or a glue gun.



12 Insert a string into one of the tips to hang your star. Well done!
